Decolonization: The action or process of a state withdrawing from a former colony - leaving it independent.

It is now used to talk about restorative justice through cultural, psychological, and economic freedom. In most countries, Indigenous people still don't hold significant positions of power or self-determination.

**Decolonization** requires non-Indigenous **Canadians** to recognize and accept the reality of **Canada's** colonial history, accept how that history paralyzed Indigenous Peoples, and how it continues to subjugate Indigenous Peoples
